Duke Energy (NYSE: DUK), a Fortune 150 company headquartered in Charlotte, N.C., is one of America's largest energy holding companies. Its electric utilities serve 8.2 million customers in North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida, Indiana, Ohio and Kentucky and collectively own 50,000 megawatts of energy capacity. Its natural gas unit serves 1.7 million customers in North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Ohio and Kentucky. The company employs 28,000 people.

Duke Energy is executing an aggressive clean energy transition to achieve its goals of net-zero methane emissions from its natural gas business and at least a 50% carbon reduction from electric generation by 2030 and net-zero carbon emissions by 2050. The 2050 net-zero goals also include Scope 2 and certain Scope 3 emissions.

For over 185 years, Duke Energy Ohio, Duke Energy Kentucky and their predecessor companies have provided safe, clean, affordable and reliable electric and natural gas to customers in southwest Ohio and Northern Kentucky.

There are nearly 2,200 employees and more than 5,400 retirees across the region, which encompasses more than 3,000 square miles.

Region-Specific Operational Facts

- 770,711 electric and 411,300 natural gas customers in southwest Ohio
- 154,000 electric and 101,200 natural gas customers in Northern Kentucky
- Virtually all available customers in Ohio have certified digital meters and the company has installed automated equipment on the distribution system to reduce and prevent customer outages
- 1,700 miles of transmission lines and 19,800 miles of distribution lines
- 7,500 miles of natural gas main lines and 6,700 miles of natural gas service lines
